Vendors may begin to setup the during the afternoon of Thursday, August 12 after 3 pm, to allow ample time to ensure technical and logistical issues are worked out before the park opens to the public. Vendors must be able to provide any accessories needed for their display area.

Vendor space may be reserved by pre-payment or a deposit of half of the amount of booth space needed. Payments must be accompanied by a completed Vendor Registration Form in order for the booth to be reserved.
